


## **1st Semester Summary**

## TN Initiatives

#### **Third grade Retention Law**


Tennessee law, <u>T.C.A. 49-6-3115</u>, passed in 2021, third-grade students who don't show proficiency on the English Language Arts (ELA) section of the Tennessee Comprehensive Program (TCAP) may have requirements related to summer school and/or tutoring to be promoted to fourth grade.

### 4th grade Retention Law

Students who were promoted to 4th Grade through pathways of the TN initiative, must demonstrate adequate growth on the 4th Grade ELA TCAP to be promoted to 5th grade.

Students who do not show adequate growth on 4th Grade ELA TCAP, will be retained to 4th Grade.
